Toilet Bombs:

A fun and eco-friendly way to clean your porcelain throne

Necessary materials:

- ¼ cup of Citric Acid
- 1 cup of Baking Soda
- Water in a spray bottle
- Essentials Oils
- Large Mixing Bowl
- Mixing Spoon
- Small Mold (ice tray or mini cupcake tray)

The Procedure:

Step 1: Measure out your citric acid and baking soda and add them into the bowl, mixing with the spoon







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Step 2: Add in twenty drops of essential oils. I like to do ten drops of sweet orange essential oil and ten drops of lemongrass essential oil. Essential oils like eucalyptus and tea tree oil are known for their disinfectant properties. During this step



be creative and create your own beautifully fragrant concoction!

Step 3: Start adding in sprays of water to your toilet bomb mixture. It is important not to add too much water to this mixture or your baking soda and citric acid will continue to react while you are trying to put it into the mold creating large air pocket filled toilet bombs that are less potent. Make sure to continue to mix well after every couple of



sprays to incorporate the water into the mixture. When you are able to take a piece of toilet bomb mixture and pinch it together without it crumbling, you have successfully added the correct amount of water. Your masterpiece is near finished!

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Step 4: After your mixture is done add it into your mold. I personally have a mini cupcake baking tray that I love to use for toilet bombs. If you don't have one an ice cube tray would also work well. If you don't have ac-



cess to either of the items I mentioned above be creative! Roll your toilet bombs into cool shapes.

Step 5: Let your toilet bombs sit and solidify for 6 to 8 hours. After this amount of time has elapsed it should be extremely easy to pop the bath bombs out of their molds. After this, they are ready to use!
